Dark red berries, cranberries, plums, soy and violets on the nose. The palate is a powerful wall of fruit as the tannins and acidity race around your mouth which finally fantail out to a mix of minerals and dark black fruits on the finish.

"Made from Spanish and Portuguese varietals (Tempranillo, Garnacha, and Souzao), the inky/ruby/purple-hued 2004 The Sticks and Stones offers up aromas of graphite, blueberries, camphor, roasted meats, and smoked herbs. It is a rich, full-bodied, exotic red with a singular character that should prove to be relatively longlived given its tannic structure. Consume it over the next 10-12 years."
